MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU)

1. Preamble
This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is executed on this day of, 20, between:
EthicBizz , a educational technology skill development organization working in the domains of cybersecurity, artificial intelligence, web development, and innovation, hereinafter referred to as "EthicBizz",
and
(Institution Name), located at, hereinafter
referred to as "the Institution".
Both parties hereby agree to collaborate to establish an EB School model focused on cybersecurity, AI, and emerging technologies through innovative education, project-based learning, and global certification pathways.

2. Purpose of the MoU

The purpose of this MoU is to establish an EB School and an EB Centre for Applied Cybersecurity & AI (ECACA) within the Institution to:

- Deliver structured cybersecurity, AI, cloud, and digital technology education
- Provide hands-on experiential learning and projects
- Build student capability through a multi-level curriculum framework (EPC–ERWA–ECP)
- Facilitate certification pathways, industry mentorship, and innovation
- Strengthen 21st-century skills, NEP-aligned education, and institutional brand value

This MoU outlines the responsibilities, deliverables, implementation framework, program structure, and governance required to operationalize the EB School model.

3. Scope of Collaboration

The collaboration includes:

- 1. Establishment of the EB School and ECACA inside the Institution
- 2. Joint delivery of the EthicBizz Curriculum Framework

- 3. Conducting workshops, events, bootcamps, hackathons, and capstone showcases
- 4. Faculty development programs (FDPs)
- 5. Access to training resources, tools, and learning materials
- 6. Participation in national- and global-level certification pathways
- 7. Joint branding and promotion of institutional achievements

4. Responsibilities of EthicBizz

EthicBizz agrees to:

4.1 Curriculum & Program Delivery

- Deliver the full curriculum under EPC, ERWA, and ECP
- Conduct regular training sessions through qualified trainers and mentors
- Provide cloud-based, ethical, and secure learning environments
- Ensure all cybersecurity activities remain within safe, sandboxed labs

4.2 Mentorship & Events

- Provide industry mentors for advanced sessions
- Conduct hackathons, workshops, bootcamps, and expert talks
- Support students in planning and executing capstone projects

4.3 Evaluation & Reports

- Maintain attendance, performance, and project logs
- Provide monthly, quarterly, and annual reports
- Evaluate capstone projects using standardized rubrics

4.4 Branding & Certification Pathways

- Support institution branding as an EB School
- Provide templates, certificates, digital badges
- Guide students toward EC-Council, Microsoft, or relevant certifications

5. Responsibilities of the Institution

The Institution agrees to:

5.1 Infrastructure

- Provide a dedicated classroom/lab for ECACA
- Ensure internet connectivity, projector/LED, and seating arrangements
- Provide administrative support for scheduling sessions and events

5.2 Coordination

- Appoint a dedicated Faculty Coordinator
- Facilitate communication and student registration
- Support awareness sessions, student mobilisation, and attendance tracking

5.3 Support for Events & Programs

- Allocate space for bootcamps, fests, and showcases
- Allow co-branding on official posters, displays, and institutional media
- Support participation of faculty in FDPs

6. Financial Terms

- 1. The program will run on a mutually-agreed fee model:
 - Per-student model, OR
 - Per-batch model, OR
 - o Institutional annual package
- 2. The financial structure, payment terms, and batch sizes will be formalized through a **Financial Annexure** signed separately prior to batch commencement.
- 3. Certification fees (if applicable) will be paid by the student or institution unless otherwise specified.

7. Duration & Validity

- This MoU is valid for 2 years from the date of signing.
- It may be **renewed** upon mutual consent.
- The program activities begin immediately after the onboarding phase.

8. Confidentiality

Both parties agree to maintain confidentiality regarding:

- Student data
- Institutional policies
- Internal academic performance records
- Proprietary curriculum, tools, and content shared by EthicBizz

9. Intellectual Property Rights (IPR)

- All curriculum, training content, tools, and materials provided by EthicBizz remain its intellectual property.
- Student-created projects remain the intellectual property of students and the Institution, with EthicBizz having permission to feature them (with consent) for educational and promotional use.

10. Review & Governance

A joint review committee will meet:

- Monthly for activity review
- Quarterly for performance evaluation
- Annually to plan scaling, additional streams, and improvements

Governance will follow the structure outlined in $\mbox{\bf Annexure}~\mbox{\bf C}.$

9. Termination Clause

Either party may terminate the MoU under the following conditions:

- 60-day written notice
- Material breach of agreed responsibilities
- Force majeure conditions

In case of termination:

- Ongoing student batches will be completed
- Fees already paid will follow the Financial Annexure terms
